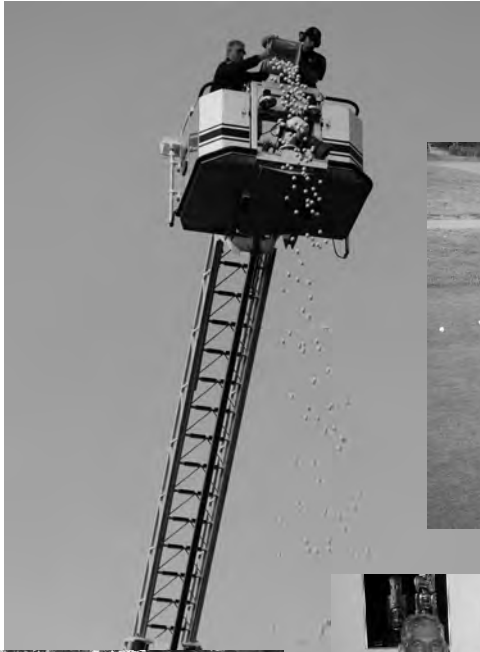

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

I have been involved with Boys & Girls Clubs for several years now and one thing I have recognized and greatly appreciated is the uncanny ability of this organization to simply just keep going regardless of what is thrown at them. As costs go up and the economy slides south, the indomitable spirit of this organization just “keeps on trucking” – to use a phrase from the decade we were founded (in Victoria)!

How do we do it? It is the Board members, the volunteers, the staff who know, to paraphrase a wise individual, that we need to fill a child's bucket of self-esteem so high that the rest of the world can't poke enough holes in it to drain it dry. These committed individuals had, somewhere along the line, the opportunities, experiences and supports that allowed them to build their own support systems. They are able to weather diversity and know they can accomplish just about anything.

Those are the same skills and internal capacities that we seek to build in the children and youth that participate in our programs. It is all about building the foundation for kids to realize their potential and make healthy choices. I said it last year and it bears repeating - the caring relationships that our staff form with our program participants can often be the turning point in keeping them from the risky behaviours that can result in them living on the street.

This year we lost a strong supporter when Peter Spillette passed away last fall. Peter knew the value of our work – he heard about it first hand at one of our AGMs. In his own words: “In June 2003, I attended the Boys & Girls Club AGM. A young man spoke about a program at the Boys & Girls Club that saved

his life. At twenty years old, he had been able to secure his first full-time job. It did not seem that remarkable until he told us that he had worked as a male prostitute in Vancouver for the previous eight years. At that point, I was convinced this organization had a lot to offer the community. The Metchosin camp is just another step in helping kids get a decent start in life.”

This Annual Report is dedicated to Peter's memory. Through his influence he brought his fellow Canadian Tire dealers on board with a \$20,000 donation towards the building of the new Harbourside Club. In addition, we have received a total of \$26,560 in Jump Start grants that helps children participate in sports or recreational activities. That influence continued with the Metchosin Camp project and to date we have received \$27,834 from Canadian Tire in support of the camp. In total, we have received over \$88,000 from Canadian Tire. Peter and his wife, Jill, also made a substantial personal contribution to the campaign. He walked the talk and he will be greatly missed.

In closing, I thank all of our supporters for their generosity – you demonstrate how much you care about kids through your support. Please. Never stop caring.

MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR OF DEVELOPMENT

A seminal time for me this year was during the unfolding of the tale of the closing and re-opening of City Central Club. The power of stories, no matter how short, never became more apparent. It began nearly fifty years ago...

The original Boys Club was founded in 1960 at 1240 Yates Street in the old fire hall to keep boys off the street and as the founding Executive Director said, "... to provide boys with a direction in social and vocational development. We encourage them to do something constructive during their leisure time instead of roaming around looking for something to do."

Over the years we've strived to provide the best and most relevant services possible for the boys, girls and families in Greater Victoria. In 1979 due to changing demographics and the opening of a similar program by the nearby Fernwood Community Centre, the after-school care program at Yates Street was closed. We felt there was no point in duplicating efforts in this area.

When Central Junior High School became a middle school in 2002 with a student population in the 10-14 age range, we saw an obvious need to once again provide after-school programs for those students. For the younger students coming from the five feeder elementary schools to a large school like Central it could be a little overwhelming. We wanted to provide safe, accessible, and age-attractive programs that encouraged educational, recreational, and social skill improvement. In September 2002, we opened City Central at 1240 Yates Street to youth ages 10-14 and participants were able to enjoy fulfilling activities (e.g. woodworking, pottery, ping-pong, foosball, billiards, computer use, sports, rock climbing, out trips) in an environment that was safe and fun. Attendance grew steadily and in 2006/2007 there were over 100 members with an average daily drop-in rate of 28 youth.

Due to supervision issues in the huge facility on

Yates with three levels and the nature of drop-in programs, however, we had youth in parts of the facility with no direct supervision. Funding restraints prevented us from hiring more staff and the decision was made not to re-open in September 2007. Our other after school programs' operating budgets were supplemented through licensed after-school programs but this was not the case with City Central. We had to heavily subsidize the City Central program as very few youth attending paid our minimal registration fees. Parent involvement was minimal at best.

It was very distressing to a lot of us when we had to close the City Central Club. And now comes the "ah hah" moment! I had to ask four young boys playing basketball in the gym in the fall of 2007 to leave as there was no one to supervise them. One of them looked up at me and asked me "Who is going to supervise us on the street?" Wow! What more impetus did we need?

Kyla Sanderson and I applied for funding for a Sears After-School Enhancement grant for \$10,000 and were successful. I followed up with applications to the Victoria Foundation and Coast Capital Savings. The Victoria Foundation initially responded by bringing to my attention a donor, the Rotary Club of Victoria, who was looking for a youth program to fund. After a visit by their President and the Chair of their funding committee and some discussion, they committed to a grant of \$20,000. We then heard from Coast Capital Savings and they committed to a grant of \$20,000 over two years. The Victoria Foundation came on board with a contribution of just shy of \$8,000. We also had money from the ViaTec floor hockey tournament and Tinhorn Creek Winery plus a couple of contributions from individuals. We were able to open five days a week and are well positioned to continue programming until the end of 2009.

It was that line "Who is going to supervise us on the street?" that we believe really convinced all of these funders that this was a need that

had to be met. But the need is ongoing and we will continue to seek out those people with whom that line resonates the most.

Thank you so much to Sears, The Victoria Foundation, the Rotary Club of Victoria, Coast Capital Savings, Tinhorn Creek Winery, the ViaTec Floor Hockey group (Metamend,

TELUS, Schneider Electric, ParetoLogic and Reliable Controls), and Mrs. Patricia Young – you are all heroes in our book!

TREASURER’S REPORT

In spite of the financial market downturn, the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Victoria Foundation grew by over 20% last year. This was primarily from contributions to our Create a Ripple campaign which are helping us to construct new cabins and washrooms at our Metchosin Wilderness Camp.

When looking at the comparative figures for 2008, please keep in mind the Foundation changed its fiscal year end to January 31, therefore only reporting 10 months of operations last year. The timing of this change came just prior to our largest fundraising event (Monopoly Madness), therefore comparative figures do not show the revenue or expenses in the prior year (2008) for this event.

Total contributions and revenue for the Foundation total \$883,381 with a net excess of \$477,806. The Foundation distributed \$189,287 to support programs operated by Boys & Girls Club Services and shared proceeds from the Monopoly Madness event with BC Paraplegic Association in the amount of \$62,346.

The cash balances for the Foundation total \$363,994 and investments total \$766,015. While the Foundation has a conservative investment plan to preserve capital, it was

not immune from the global financial market events. As with most investors who held stocks and equities, the Foundation saw its investments fall by approximately 25% creating an investment loss of \$77,911. At the time you are reading this report, the investments have regained approximately 6% of their value.

The Foundation has reduced the mortgage payable during the year by \$146,400 leaving a remaining balance of \$186,000. We have been able to pay down the mortgage from \$980,000 (balance at March 31, 2004) due to the great success of the Create a Ripple Campaign.

To all of our supporters – those who gave so generously to our Annual Appeal, the Create A Ripple Campaign, those who responded to our newsletter, those who remembered a dear friend or family member by contributing to our Endowment Funds – we offer our sincerest thanks.

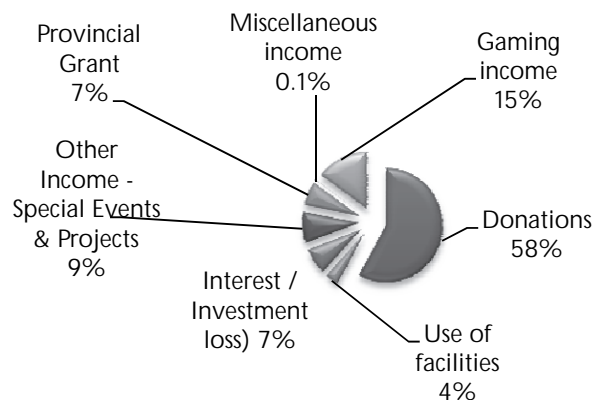

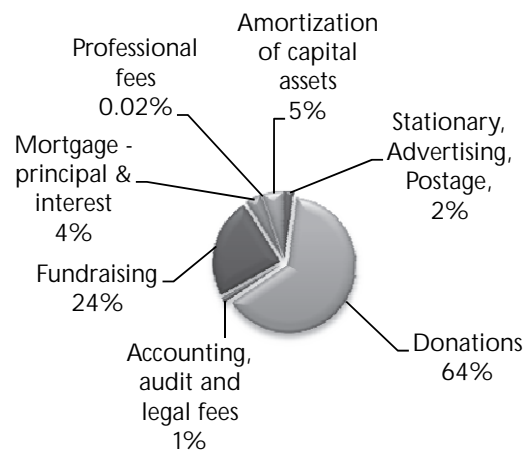

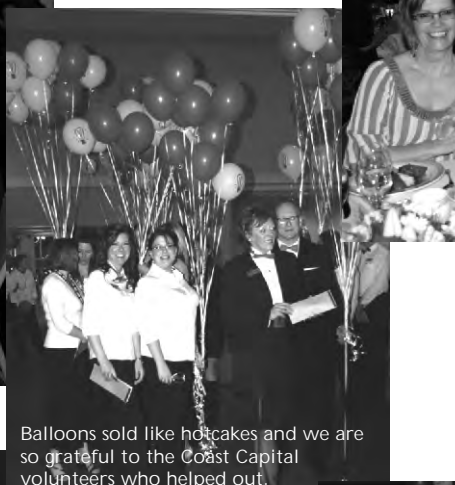
