The role:

Under the direct supervision of the Club Coordinator the One-to-One Youth Programmer is assigned a participant and is responsible for providing support and assisting with the participant's integration into the club's daily programs. Programming will take place in the context of the Youth Drop –In Program.

Qualifications and requirements:

- Post secondary education in a related field (minimum 20 hours education in Child Development, Safety and /or Health & Nutrition)
- Minimum 1 year hands on experience working with children & youth with diverse abilities
- Demonstrated behavioral management experience
- Excellent communication skills both written and verbal
- Ability to meet CRD licensing requirements for criminal record check(**must be provided on commencement of employment**)
- Demonstrated creative program planning
- current first aid and CPR certification
- Medical note, stating “mentally and physically capable to work with children”

Key duties and responsibilities include:

The Programmer is expected to build a relationship with the participant, and work with the overall club staff team to ensure the participant's' successful integration. This candidate will be expected to follow the short and long term goals of the participant and communicate accomplishments and struggles with the child's parent and support worker. The successful candidate will bring to their role energy, creativity, dependability, organization, a passion for empowering all youth and a general attitude of support to the community club and agency.
